Registration, Pricing & Refunds

Registration

- We require registration forms to be completed for each child.
- Pre-registration is required for all participants.
- Summer Experience Authorization Form, Informed Consent & Wavier Forms are required to participate.
- All forms will be provided to participants before the start of selected programs.
- Forms must be returned to the Museum Office by the first day of the selected program.

Pricing

Full Week Program: Members \$250 per child/week
Full Week Program: Non-Members \$275 per child/week

Discounts

Member Discount: Member families receive a discount on our program fees. To take advantage of the savings, you must hold, establish, or renew a Family Membership (\$60 Annually) Members enjoy free admission to the Museum, discounts in our Museum Shoppe, and program discounts throughout the year.

Early Bird: Program fees paid in full by June 1st will receive a 10% discount.

Multi-Child: A 10% discount will be credited to the program fees of additional children from the same family.

Refund Policy

A 100% refund, minus credit card fees, will be granted for cancellations made 3 weeks (21 days) or more before your program start date.

A 50% refund, minus credit card fees, will be granted for cancellations made 7-20 days before your program start date.

No refunds will be granted for cancellations made 6 days or less before Your program start date.

Cancellations

We reserve the right to cancel any program due to low enrollment and any other circumstance beyond our control.

A 100% refund will be granted for any program that we must cancel.
